
5. General remarks

6. Removing the covers



Step 1)

The place of installation is located at the back seat of your car.



Step 2)

Remove the ISOFIX-mounts.



Step 3)

Now you have to remove the backseat. Therefore you have to pull slightly the backseat from top down. It is only clipped in, you don't have to remove any screws. Work carefully and watch out for connected lines.



Step 4)

Once you have removed the backseat, you have to clear your workspace.





Step 5) Expose the Gateway

In the middle of the backseat you can find a cover, which has to be removed. Under the cover you will see the Gateway.

For exposing the control unit just lift up the cover.




Step 6) Expose the Gateway

In the next step you have to unlock the plug of the control unit. After unlocking the plug, just pull it off.



Step 7) Expose the Gateway

Pull down the rail latch with a screw driver on both sides.



Step 8) Clearing the distibutor


For clearing the distributor you just have to pull off the unlocked case of the plug.






Step 9) Clearing the distibutor

Pin out the wire with the color orange / red (orange wire with red stripe).




Step 10) Pinning in new wiring harness

In the free pin slots you have to pin in the orange / black wire (orange wire with black stripe) from the new wire harness.



Step 11) Clearing the distibutor

Now pin out the twisted pair of the orange / brown wire (orange wire with brown stripe) of the opposite side.



Step 12) Pinning in new wiring harness

In the free pin slots you have to pin in the orange / brown wire (orange wire with brown stripe) from the new wire harness.






Step 13) Empty Housing

The original wire (orange/red) has to be pinned in in pin 1 of the enclosed empty housing.

The original wire (orange/brown) has to be pinned in in pin 2 of the enclosed empty housing.




Step 14) Connecting the plugs

Now bring together the plugs or rather the adapter and stow them carefully.



Step 15) Wire installation

The wire has to be installed to the ASC on the right side of the (rear-)trunk.



Step 16) Wire installation

We strongly suggest to install the wire to the original harness of the vehicle.





Step 13) Connection to the ASC harness

After you have installed the wires to the (rear-) trunk you can connect them to the ASC harness.

If everything is installed you can start reinstalling the backseat.

To activate the venting, you need to set the Show-Mode to 0mm for front and rear axle.

If you do not want to use the venting, you can select the desired value for the Show-Mode as usual.
